Cambodia energy storage power export



Overview

How much power does Cambodia import?

Cambodia currently has contracts to import 1,030 MW of power from Thailand, Vietnam, and Laos, according to the U.S. International Trade Administration, accounting for nearly a quarter of total capacity used to supply power to the country.

What are the main sources of electricity in Cambodia?

Major sources of local power generation are hydro and coal, and minor sources include diesel, wood, and biomass. In addition to local power generation, Cambodia also buys electricity from neighboring countries, especially during the dry season.

How many MW will Cambodia import from Laos?

SINGAPORE, Oct 21 (Reuters) - Cambodia plans to import over 600 megawatts (MW) of clean power from neighbouring Laos, Vietnam and Thailand, its energy minister Keo Rottanak told Reuters, increasing its contracted import capacity by over 50%. The southeast Asian nation will import 300 MW of solar and hydro capacity from Laos starting in 2026.

How much electricity does Cambodia have in 2022?

In 2022, Cambodia's total installed capacity amounted to 4,495 megawatts (MW), while 1,030 MW of power was imported from Thailand, Vietnam, and Laos. The Electricity Authority of Cambodia (EAC) predicts that the total installed capacity will increase to 4,945 MW of electricity in 2023.

How is energy used in Cambodia?

Total energy supply (TES) includes all the energy produced in or imported to a country, minus that which is exported or stored. It represents all the energy required to supply end users in the country.

How has the energy supply in Cambodia changed over the years?

Total primary energy supply (TPES) increased by 5.8% per year in 2000–2010 and by 8.0% per year in 2010–2019, showing the same trend as that of TFEC. Due to the significant increase in electricity demand, Cambodia rapidly increased its hydropower and coal power generation in 2010–2019.
