Before you travel, check the information below to make sure your electronic devices are compatible with the outlet type and voltage. Chile uses outlet types C, L at a voltage of 220V and a frequency of 50 Hz. Plug Compatibility: Type C, L Voltage: 220V Frequency: 50 Hz.

What is the mains voltage in Chile?

Just like most of South America, the voltage in Chile is 230 volts and the frequency is 50 Hz. Chile has standardized on the Italian grounded plug/socket, which includes two styles rated at 10 and 16 amperes. Both plug top styles consist of three rounded pins.

The Standard Voltage used in Chile is 220-240V — that's double North and Central America's standard voltage, but the same as in Europe, Australia, and most of the world. The Standard Frequency used in Chile is 50Hz — the same as most of the world, but in North and Central America, it's 60Hz. The.

In Chile, power plugs and sockets (outlets) of type C and type L are used. The standard voltage is 220 V at a frequency of 50 Hz. Chile is a country of stunning natural beauty, from the. What plug types and power outlets are used in Chile?

The Standard Plug Types and Power Outlets used in Chile are: Adapter vs. Converter An Adapter (aka plug adapter or power adapter) is used to adapt the physical shape of the plug so that it can be plugged into a different type of power outlet or socket. It doesn't transform the voltage of the power source.

Do you need a power adapter in Chile?

While much of Latin America uses the same power outlets as the USA, Chile does not, so travelers coming from North America will need to pack a power adapter. There are two types of plugs used in Chile, type C and type L. The type C plug is known as the "Euro Plug" since it's the same plug used in most of Europe.

Do US plugs fit in Chilean power outlets?

During my adventures in Chile, I quickly realized that US plugs don't fit into Chilean power outlets. Chile primarily uses two types of outlets: Type C (two round pins) and Type L (three round pins). These are quite different from the flat-pronged plugs we're used to in the States.

Are there electrical outlets in Chile?

No, the electrical outlets in Chile are different from those in the United States. In Chile electrical outlets of types C & L are used, while the United States has electrical outlets of types A & B. Do I need a travel adapter for Chile?

The electrical outlets and power plugs in Chile are of types C & L (see images).

What type of power socket is used in Chile?

The power sockets in Chile are of type C and L. The standard voltage is 220 V at a frequency of 50 Hz. Check your need for a power plug (travel) adapter in Chile.

What is the standard voltage for a power socket in Chile?

All power sockets in Chile provide a standard voltage of 220V with a standard frequency of 50Hz. You can use all your equipment in Chile if the outlet voltage in your own country is between 220V-240V. This is the case in most of Europe, Australia, the United Kingdom and most countries in Africa and Asia.
