Is it suitable to bring an outdoor power bank to Samoa

In Samoa, they use Type I power plugs and outlets. The voltage is 230V, and the frequency is 50Hz. So, you'll need a travel adapter in Samoa. Their plugs and outlets are different from the Type A and B ones we use back in the States. Need a travel adapter?

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What is the plug for Samoa?

Before you travel, check the information below to make sure your electronic devices are compatible with the outlet type and voltage. Plug Compatibility: Type I Voltage: 220V – 240V Frequency: 50 Hz Can North Americans use Electronics in Samoa without an Adapter?

In American Samoa, power plugs and sockets (outlets) of type A, type B, type F and type I are used. The standard voltage is 120 V at a frequency of 60 Hz. American Samoa is a beautiful group of islands located in the South Pacific Ocean. This U.S. territory is known for its stunning beaches, lush.

Do I need a power adapter in Samoa?

What type of plug does Samoa use?

For Samoa the associated plug type is I, which is the plug that has three flat pins in a triangular pattern. Samoa operates on a 230V supply voltage and 50Hz. Electricity supplies worldwide can vary from anything between 100V and 240V. It can be extremely dangerous to use an electrical appliance that is rated at a voltage different from the supply.

What is the electrical current in Samoa?

The electrical current in Samoa is 230v AC 50Hz, so if you are coming from a country such as the Americas, your electrical devices will either have a 110v/240v switch on the item or you will need to make sure your travel adapter also converts voltage.

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
