Rooftop solar panels tiling

If you have a tile roof and are considering solar energy, you might be wondering whether your roof can handle solar panels. Tile roofs—especially lightweight cement or clay tiles—are beautiful and durable but also delicate. Unlike asphalt shingles, they can crack easily under pressure, which makes solar installation a bit more challenging.

How do I install solar panels on a lightweight tile roof?

The best way to install solar panels on a lightweight tile roof is through a method called inset solar installation, also known as a “comp-out” installation. This technique removes the section of tile where the solar panels will be installed and replaces it with composite shingles before mounting the solar array.

Why do you need a tile roof hook Solar System?

The use of a high-quality tile roof hook solar setup prevents leaks, keeps your tiles intact, and ensures your solar panels can stand up to wind, rain, and temperature fluctuations without shifting or causing stress to the roof below.

1. Standard Tile Hook This is the most commonly used style.

Can solar panels be installed on lightweight tiles?

If installers attempt to mount solar panels directly onto lightweight tiles, several issues can arise: Tile breakage: Walking on or drilling through these tiles can cause cracks or breaks, which may lead to roof leaks and structural damage.

How do you install solar panels on a new roof?

Mounting the solar panels – Once the new roof section is complete, a solar

expert installs the racking system and solar panels securely onto the composite shingles. Unlike tile, these shingles can handle the weight and pressure of solar mounting without breaking.

What is a tile roof?

Tile roofs are common in the Western and Southwestern U.S., where the climate is warm and dry. These roofs, often called Spanish tile or terra cotta tile, come in different shapes, such as “W,” “S,” or flat tile. One of the biggest challenges with tile roofs is their fragility.
