The Government of Liberia, through the Ministry of Information, Culture, and Tourism (MICAT), has announced the dedication of the country's first solar power plant, a 20-megawatt solar farm located in Grand Bassa County, scheduled for October 2025. By: Kruah Thomson Monrovia, September 12, 2025:.

Work has begun on a 20 MW solar plant in Liberia, on the site of an existing 88 MW hydropower station. The Liberian government says it is the first of several planned projects that will help to address the country's power shortages, particularly in the dry season. Construction is underway on.

President Joseph N. Boakai on Friday, October 11, 2024, broke grounds for the construction of Liberia's first 20 Megawatts solar farm at the Mount Coffee Power Plant. President Boakai said the 20MW solar farm will address power shortage during the dry season through the integration of solar energy.
