The updated National Energy Roadmap (NERM) 2016 recognized the dual importance of renewable energy and energy efficiency as pivotal to achieve the NERM's vision of energizing Vanuatu's growth and development through the provision of secure, affordable, widely accessible, high quality, clean energy.

Vanuatu is accelerating its shift towards a low-carbon future, integrating the principles of just transition into national energy and climate strategies, with a strong focus on renewable energy, green transport, and local skills development. Vanuatu's National Energy Road Map (NERM) was considered and endorsed by the Council of Ministers in 2013. The NERM is the policy framework for developing the energy sector in Vanuatu. The NERM identified five priorities for the energy sector: access, petroleum supply, affordability, energy.

The Governments of New Zealand and Vanuatu have signed a Partnership Arrangement to advance the Renewable Energy Solar and Storage on Efate and Tanna (RESSET) Project, a major initiative aimed at strengthening Vanuatu's energy and climate resilience. achieve close to 100 percent Renewable Energy through solar and storage in Efate and.

The renewable energy systems have also enabled the safe storage of medicines and vaccines, crucial for effective healthcare services. Through its National Energy Road Map and in line with the goals of its Nationally Determined Contribution (NDC) under the Paris Agreement, Vanuatu aims for 100.
