The CBN stations have stable pillars with forced-centering plates intended for multi-epoch high-accuracy GNSS positioning. On average, the pillars are at 200 km spacing in most of southern Canada, 500 km in the northern part of the larger provinces, and 1000 km in the Territories.

What is a green communication initiative?
